



Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) Best Practices – Distance Learning programme

Three-month distance learning programme

Environment and Health & Safety are a vital component of every business. Emerging issues like climate change, hazardous and solid waste management and escalating costs of energy threaten the business sustainability like never before. Also, in India at least 40,000 workers die every year at work and millions get exposed to hazardous working conditions. Despite a plethora of laws and regulations being enacted, there is a lack of a proper understanding and stringent implementation of these regulations.

For filling these gaps, the CII - ITC Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Development (CESD) offers the unique distance learning course Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) Best Practices. It develops the knowledge and practical skills to implement, assess and improve EHS management systems in Indian workplaces. Participants benefit from a CII certificate of participation.

Objectives of the Programme

The main objectives of the programme are to:

- Provide knowledge on assessing and improving the environmental performance, work safety and health in the workplace
- Develop practical skills with respect to implementation and auditing of EHS management systems in Indian workplaces
- Build knowledge on applicable national legislations and regulations

Methodology

Using a Blended Learning approach, the programme is conducted online including the examination. The participant will complete nine self-learning modules, case studies and a major project over a three-month period. Participants can complete the EHS modules at their own pace and on their own time. Registration for the programme is open at any time of the year.

The course is developed as three-month distance learning programme.
