



LEAD AUDITOR TRAINING COURSE FOR ENVIRONMENT HEALTH & SAFETY

(ISO 14001:2015 and OHSAS 18001:2007)

The 5-day course equips the participants with the necessary auditing skills through classroom teaching, open forum discussions, group exercises and case studies. The course is conducted by experienced faculty who have more than 20 years of industry experience.

Pre-requisites: Basic knowledge of ISO 14001:2015 and OHSAS 18001:2007 is recommended.

To equip participants with the auditing skills to organize, manage and conduct Environment, Health & Safety management systems audit as per international standards (ISO 14001:2015 and OHSAS 18001:2007).

To understand the principles and techniques as per Auditing Standards 19011.

To provide insight of the environmental aspects and impacts, hazards, risk assessments and key compliances.

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Each participant shall be evaluated against the two independent elements mentioned- both of which need to be fulfilled to successfully complete the course.

- a) Continuous evaluation: This will be based on attentiveness, participation in individual and group exercises, quizzes organized during the course. Continuous evaluation constitutes 40% of total weightage.
- b) Written examination: It forms 60% of the total weightage. It evaluates the participants having understanding about audit process, application of ISO 14001, OHSAS 18001 & ISO 19011 and their ability to provide written justification of their observation/non-conformities etc.
