Key Responsibilities:

- Design process and workflows to collect structured data on land management and agronomy practices in intervened villages through multiple data collection drives in an agricultural year.
- Lead the team of field volunteers to collect high quality data while continuous providing feedback to improve processes on field and disseminate key overall findings back to the implementing team and farming communities.
- Standardise training material for master trainers and farmers to build capacity of farmers and partners on the ground for sustained adoption new practices.
- Develop standard operating procedures for maintaining quality of data and train field volunteers on these SOPs for these good practices. Verify and validate these processes with real-time checks or field visits.
- Document various land management and agronomy practices as well as technology pilots and ex-situ solutions with geo-tagged photographs of field preparation/tools & techniques, stakeholder interviews etc.
- Assist applied research on crop residue management by undertaking primary data analyses, quick literature reviews, building case studies of progressive farmers/ Farmer co-ops etc.
- Liaise with field coordinators, local partners, farmer groups, donor industries, concerned departments and cohort groups of progressive farmers for coordinating their inputs and building stakeholder-wide consensus on solutions.
- Statistically analysis of primary data for publication in various internationally reputed scientific journals and various CII reports.

- 2-3 years of work experience with masters in relevant areas such as agronomy, soil science, GIS etc.
- Experience in statistical analysis and design of experiment is must for this job
